The sketch will be released at 2pm today and the juvenile will be available on the second floor conference room to provide a sound and video. The victim has requested to remain anonymous so accommodations will need to be made.

On October 21, 2013 at approximately 240 pm, the juvenile reportee exited her school bus at the above listed location. The juvenile observed the above listed male sitting under a bush next to the sidewalk. The juvenile walked past the male and he got up and began to follow her. The juvenile began to run and the male then began to run after her. The juvenile screamed "help" very loud and ran into the Camden community, and the male stopped following her and ran to the above vehicle that was parked across the street.

A composite sketch of the male is being completed and will be released when it becomes available.
