3<sup>rd</sup> Suspect - Mauricio Quintero, 27yoa, 6-6-1986, 2573 SW 121 Terr. Miramar, Florida

Further investigation into this incident revealed the identity of a 3<sup>rd</sup> suspect and the identity of one of the female suspects. The 3<sup>rd</sup> suspect is Mauricio Quintero (H/M/6-6-86). Mr Quintero was identified by the victim, as the subject who took possession of all the property at the end of the night and transferred it into his vehicle. On 11/7/13, Mr Quintero was taken into custody and is currently in the Broward County jail awaiting trial. He refused to provide any information as to the identity of the other 2 suspects.

The female suspect (green shirt) has been identified as Ana Cordero-Noriega (H/F/6-12-79), aka Ana Maria Moreno Rivadeneyra, and Ana Cordero-Pitre. Ms Cordero-Noriega has an open warrant for her arrest, and is being sought out in connection to this crime.

Surveillance video is now available at the Pembroke Pines Police Department (9500 Pines Blvd). The video shows both suspects, along with the victim, at different stores within the city. The first portion of the video was obtained from the Best Buy store, inside Pembroke Lakes mall. The second portion of the video was inside the JC Penney store, also inside Pembroke Lakes mall, and the last part of the video was at the exit of the Wal Mart, at 12600 Pines Blvd.

On 9/25/13 the victim, who is an 83 year old female, was shopping in the Sedano's plaza at 10345 Pines Blvd. As she approached one of the stores, she was stopped by suspect 1. Suspect 1 stated that she had a winning lottery ticket and needed assistance in claiming the prize. Suspect 1 added that she was "undocumented" and could not come forward to claim the winnings. She therefore needed 2 people to assist her in getting the money. For her assistance suspect 1 offered the victim \$30,000.00, once the money was collected. At that time suspect 2 approached, pretending to have overheard the conversation and also offered to help. She, along with suspect 1, were then able to convince the victim to assist in obtaining the money. Once the victim agreed to help, the suspects stated that they needed a sign of "good faith", in order to give her the \$30,000.00. Subsequently, the two suspects entered the victim's vehicle and were driven to several locations in Pembroke Pines, by the victim. The suspects were able to convince the victim to make a cash withdrawal, from the victim's personal account, and turn the money over to suspect 1. Additionally they drove to several stores, where the suspects selected merchandise and had the victim pay for it. In between one of the trips to the store, the victim drove the suspects to her apartment and agreed to give them all of her jewelry. After the last transaction, the victim drove the suspects back to the Sedano's lot. The suspects stated that they needed to go in the store for some food, and asked the victim to wait in the car. Neither suspect returned.

In all, the suspects obtained the following from the victim: \$8500.00 in cash, \$6500.00 in merchandise, and \$3000.00 in jewelry.
