

MAYOR FRANK C. ORTIS' PERSONAL INVITATION

On Friday, January 31st, 2014, I will host a game show fundraiser, "Can We Make a Deal?" This event will raise money to help two very special boys. Dillon, son of Pembroke Pines Police Officer Andrew Brooks, and Niko, son of Pembroke Pines Firefighter Mike Peros.

Dillon is an autistic 8-year-old that suffers from Glioblastoma Multiforme, the most common and aggressive type of Brain Cancer. In September, Dillon underwent an initial six-hour surgery performed at Miami's Children's Hospital that removed the bulk of the tumor. However, the surgery alone wasn't enough to put him in the clear. Dillon also underwent a revolutionary brain surgery to save his life at Boston's Dana-Farber Children's Hospital. This procedure will be followed by chemo and radiation treatments.

Niko is an 18 month old little boy with Fanconi Anemia, a rare blood disease. "FA" is a genetic disease that effects 1 in every 350,000 births. Niko's type is the most aggressive and dangerous type. At 3 months, Niko had to have a kidney removed. Currently he is at Minnesota's Amplatz Children's Hospital undergoing a bone marrow transplant to fight the complications that have arisen.

WHAT IS "CAN WE MAKE A DEAL?" AND HOW DO I PLAY?

"Can We Make A Deal?" is a live game show that works as a fundraiser to help Dillon Brooks and Niko Peros

- Three (3) separate games will be played.
- On the night of the event, each ticket redeemed will be entered into a raffle to determine who will play "Can We Make a Deal?"
- From the raffle, 3 participants will be chosen to play the game and win a major prize.
- Contestant will be allowed 2 support members on stage to provide guidance during the game.
- Each game is played with 26 cases, each containing point values ranging from 1 to 5,000 points.
- The object of the game is to end the game with the highest point value possible.
- Without knowing the amount in each case, the contestant will pick one of the cases to keep.
- The player will then eliminate the remaining 25 cases, by opening the case and revealing the points inside. In each round a pre-determined number of cases will be opened.
- Then "The Banker" will give the participant an offer of points in exchange for what might be contained in the contestant's chosen case, prompting the Mayor to ask the all-important question, "Can we make a Deal?"
- As each case is opened, the likelihood of the player having a valuable amount of points in his or her own case decreases or increases, which will also change the Banker's offer.
- After 3 individual contestants play their individual game, the contestant with the most points will have first pick of the major prizes.
- Many other prizes will also be awarded from the raffle.


