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REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- All children must be at least 6 years old and have completed kindergarten at the time they begin camp. (Must provide copy of recent report card at registration).
- All Pembroke Pines residents must provide a copy of the parent's driver license with Pembroke Pines address listed, a copy of a Pembroke Pines utility bill and a copy of the child's birth certificate (birth cards are not accepted).
- All forms must be notarized if being mailed in. Only parents and/or legal guardians can register campers.
- All parents/legal guardians of campers must be year-round residents of Pembroke Pines or Broward County.
- Legal guardians must show proper legal/court documentation.
- Registration forms and payments must be completed and processed prior to child entering camp.
- Payment of one session does not guarantee placement in another session. ***There will be NO WAITING list for any of the sites.***
- To qualify for pre-registration discount, applications must be received, not postmarked by the deadline dates. Mail in deadline date is Friday, April 30, 2010.
- In order to be processed, forms must be completely filled out and notarized. Payment must be included. ***Incomplete forms will not be processed and a spot will not be held*** for your child until all forms are completed. Please review your forms carefully.
- Group assignments will be made on the basis of age. Groups will be as follows: (6-7 years), (8-9 years), and (10-11 years). We reserve the right to rearrange age groups, as we deem necessary.
- Children ages 12-15 will attend the Teen Camp. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
- If your child is on medication, the Site Supervisor must be notified in writing and a form must be completed and kept at the campsite. This is required for all medication (including aspirin and cough drops) and must be kept in the Site Supervisor's office. Children must be able to administer their own medication and be responsible for taking it at the appropriate time.

Refunds will be granted for only one week or more of camp. All refunds will be assessed a processing fee and trip portions are not refundable. There will be no daily refunds. There will be no refunds for missed trips. Please note fees that will be deducted prior to any refund requests:

- Processing fee of \$15.00 will be assessed to all requests.
- Trip portion for 6-11 year old camp is \$80.00 per session.

SIGN-IN/SIGN-OUT POLICY:

All campers must be escorted to designated area at campsite. Those who escort campers to designated area must also sign them in/out daily. **Photo identification is required at pick-up daily.**

LATE PICK-UP POLICY:

Camp ends at 6:00 p.m. A late pick-up fee of \$10.00 will be charged for the first 15 minutes, and \$1.00 for every minute thereafter. After 1 hour of no parental contact, Pembroke Pines Police Department will be contacted, and child will be taken to police station for pick-up.

DISCIPLINE POLICY:

We make every effort to control inappropriate behavior. The City of Pembroke Pines Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to skip a step depending on the severity of the behavior.

STEP #1: Verbal warning from staff and time out from activity.

STEP #2: Time away from activity and parent is contacted by Site Supervisor.

STEP #3: Conference with parent and Site Supervisor. Parent and child given discipline letter to sign. Three discipline letters may result in dismissal.

STEP #4: Suspension from field trip or activity.

STEP #5: Removal from camp.

*If taken off a trip or activity or dismissed from camp, no refunds will be given. Inappropriate behavior may also result in suspension from field trip or activity.

American Red Cross Swimming Lessons

Sessions will be held Monday through Thursday for 2 weeks or 8 consecutive Saturday mornings. The American Red Cross Learn to Swim Program teaches aquatic skills in a technical progression. The program comprises 6 skill levels, from Parent and Child Aquatic classes to Adult swim lessons. Classes are limited to 8 students, pre-registration is required.

Registration hours Monday – Thursday 1:00-4:30pm, Friday 1:00-7:00pm. At TownGate, Pembroke Lakes and Price Park Pools.

Cost: (8 lessons) Pembroke Pines Residents - \$40.00, Non-Residents - \$52.00

Parent and Child Aquatics: Builds basic water safety skills for both parents and children, helping infants and young children ages 6 months to 3 years become comfortable in the water so they are willing to learn to swim. These basic skills include adjusting to the water environment, showing comfort while maintaining a front or back position in the water and demonstrating breath control, including blowing bubbles or voluntarily submerging under water. A parent or another adult (18 years of age or older) is required in the water with participant.

Infants and toddlers are required to wear swim pants under their swimsuits, no diapers allowed.

Preschool Level I Introduction to Water Skills: Gives young children ages 4 and 5 a positive and developmentally appropriate aquatic learning experience that emphasizes water safety and survival concepts. Helps participants feel comfortable in the water. Skills include entering and exiting the water using ladder, steps or side. Blowing bubbles through mouth and nose. Bobbing, opening eyes under water and retrieving submerged items. Front and back glides and back float.

Learn-to-swim/ Level 2 Fundamental Aquatic Skills: Gives participants success with fundamental skills. Front and back glides and back float. Recover from a front and back glide to a vertical position. Treading water using arms and leg actions. Combines arm and leg actions on front and back. Fining arm action on back. Staying safe around aquatic environments.

Learn-to-swim/ Level 3 Stroke Development: Builds on the skills in Level 2 through additional guided practice in deeper waters. Rotary breathing and survival float. Changing from vertical to horizontal position on front and back. Push off in streamlined position and begin to flutter

kick and dolphin kick on front. Front crawl, elementary backstroke and the scissors kick.

Learn-to-swim/ Level 4 Stroke Improvement: Develop confidence in the skills & improves other aquatic skills. Survival swimming, front crawl and backstroke open turns. Front and back crawl, elementary backstroke, breaststroke, sidestroke and butterfly. Push off in a streamline position then begin flutter and dolphin kicks on back.

Learn-to-swim/ Level 5 Stroke Refinement: Provides further coordination and refinement of strokes. Front flip turn and backstroke flip turn while swimming. Front and back crawl, elementary backstroke, breaststroke and butterfly.

Learn-to-swim/ Level 6 Swimming and Skills Proficiency: Refines the stroke so participants swim them with ease, efficiency, power and smoothness over greater distances.

Adult: The adult program is for the person who cannot swim or who wants to refine their swimming abilities. Adults are placed in groups according to swimming ability.

***All students entering Level 3-6 must have a certificate from previous level or they must be able to demonstrate all of the completion requirements of the previous Level. Students must register in advance (FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED).**

You may only register your child for one session at a time, unless a member of the aquatics staff suggests a "refresher" class.

If classes are cancelled due to inclement weather, every attempt will be made to reschedule. A doctor's note is required for student illness. Children are otherwise expected to attend class.

Only a parent or legal guardian may register their child. Proof of residency is required to receive resident registration price.
