REPORT OF LIAISON:

Board Liaison Bonkowski reported on the "New Industry" opening at the Frank and that the opening of the "Generations" at Studio 18 was successful.

The Frank/Studio 18

- Ms. Bonkowski distributed newsletter/flyers for October for all cultural events being conducted at the Frank and Studio 18, for their reference. She specifically noted the "Arts In Education Week" for at all the locations and the "Art For The Earth" which is being hosted at the Frank on October 17, 2019 in conjunction with the Broward County Cultural Division

Art Festival

- Ms. Bonkowski advised that she continues to search out bands for the Art Festival and members are encouraged to forward to her any local bands of interest. The position of the stage was discussed concerning very little shade from the sun. She will have volunteers in place to assist the emcee with groups leaving and coming on to the stage. She reported there will be a mass social e-
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blast on September 15 to 30,000 artists in the southeast region to advise for participation.

Studio 18

- Ms. Bonkowski spoke about the 10th Anniversary of Studio 18 on August 10, 2020. A survey of the current artists was taken concerning their input for how the anniversary should be celebrated. Most of the responses focused on inviting past resident artists to attend and be recognized at the celebration events. Members were encouraged to bring suggestions for more diverse activities for the celebration at the next meeting. A video of photos from over the years was suggested by Ms. Bonkowski and Member Koren volunteered to assist in the compilation of that video presentation.
