**MARCH 31, 2022**

The regular meeting of the FSU/PINES CHARTER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADVISORY BOARD was called to order by Chair Jones at 6:02 p.m. Thursday, March 31, 2022, in the school's cafeteria at 601 SW 172 Avenue, Pembroke Pines, Florida.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited to commence the meeting.

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**OATH OF OFFICE**

Newest members, Karine Miranda and Gillian Gregory, took the oath of office for the FSU Charter Elementary School Advisory Board.

**SUNSHINE LAW PRESENTATION**

Assistant City Attorney Morgan reviewed the Sunshine Law and Public Records Law for all members.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

On a motion by Member Gregory, seconded by Vice Chair Founds, to approve the October 7, 2021 minutes, as presented, passed unanimously.

**CITY MANAGER'S REPORT**

Mr. Bonilla reported that the budget update began in January and requested that the board have a budget meeting June 2, 2022. He also discussed past fundraiser, upcoming events, and a raffle update.

Mr. Bonilla introduced Rich Passero. He provided an update regarding bus transportation, which included transportation survey results, bus cleanliness and social distancing, and bus depots. Mr. Bonilla spoke on the Reaxium partnership and shared a short video.

#### **PRINCIPAL'S REPORT**

Vice Chair Founds presented the School Improvement Plan which noted school demographics, the purpose and outline of SIP, school information, needs assessments, and planning for improvement. Member Estevez asked about science results. Vice Chair Founds said it was not included at this time.

On a motion by Member Gonzalez, seconded by Member Estevez, to approve the 2021-2022 School Improvement Plan, passed unanimously.

Dr. Sporillo reviewed the Wellness Policy and noted that the only change would be the date.

On a motion by Member Gregory, seconded by Member Llarena, to approve the 2021-2022 Wellness Policy, passed unanimously.

Dr. Sporillo spoke on ESSER/ICP. She stated that the school was approved to use these funds.

On a motion by Member Miranda, seconded by Member Gregory, to approve the ESSER III Plan, passed unanimously.

Member Miranda shared information on FSA and Dr. Sporillo mentioned several upcoming events.

On a motion by Member Gonzalez, seconded by Member Estevez, to excuse Member Davis, passed unanimously.

#### **OPEN FORUM**

A parent, Elizabeth Pinellas, spoke on Literacy Night stating that it was a great event. She asked about parents volunteering. Dr. Sporillo advised they are opening up more for outdoor events and will have volunteers soon.
