INCIDENT SUMMARY:

Our department is currently in the process of obtaining reaccreditation through the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation (CFA). The culmination of this process will take place from April 7 – 9, 2026, as our agency will host a team of CFA assessors who will conduct a final assessment of our policies, practices, and facilities. This assessment is intended to measure the agency's compliance with 213 state-recognized standards necessary to maintain a properly functioning and fully accountable police department. Over the course of the assessment, the agency's policies will be reviewed, staff will be interviewed, and physical inspections will be made to our Police Headquarters, the West District Substation, the Training Facility, and our field equipment.

Our Accreditation Team Manager, Robin Moss, will be facilitating the assessment process for our CFA Assessment Team. As part of this process, we are inviting residents to submit their

Upon the completion of the CFA assessors' on-site examination, all findings will be submitted to the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation to determine if the Pembroke Pines Police Department has satisfied all requirements to attain reaccreditation status. Once obtained, accreditation status is valid for a three (3) year period during which the department must maintain the standards set by the CFA. After the three (3) year period is over, the agency is reassessed through the same on-site examination process.

The Pembroke Pines Police Department is committed to continuous improvement through the application of CFA standards, ensuring that we always move forward in pursuit of excellence.
