DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Suspect #3 - B/M short black hair, medium build, silver teeth caps, approximately 20 Y.O.A.

Suspect #4 - B/F long black hair, pulled back, thin build, short in stature, approximately 20 Y.O.A.

Vehicle - Black, Chevrolet Malibu 4 door, older model, N.O.I.

Witness - Shifflet, Richard

At approximately 8:45 am on this date, the victim was walking north along the east sidewalk at the 200 block of South Douglas Rd. The suspect vehicle parked at the Maroone Nissan Dealership at which time the suspect exited the vehicle. The suspect walked past the victim on the sidewalk, then circled around behind her, pushed her to the ground and pulled her purse and bag from her arm. The suspect jumped back into the suspect vehicle, at which time it attempted to flee through the car dealership.

The witness, Mr. Shifflet observed the entire incident occur, and pulled into the dealership with his vehicle to assist. Mr. Shifflet blocked the suspect vehicle in the dealership with his vehicle, preventing it from leaving, and confronted the occupants while placing himself in danger. The suspect then exited the vehicle, ran back to the victim and returned the property to her. The suspect told the victim that he was only trying to prove a point, and then fled running through the car dealership. The other suspects in the get away vehicle were able to flee prior to the police arriving, leaving the listed suspect behind. The suspect was located and apprehended by PPPD Officers while trying to flee the area on the north side of

the dealership. The suspect was positively identified by several witnesses and the victim, and was subsequently arrested and charged accordingly. The victim sustained minor injuries to her leg as a result of this crime.

This case remains an ongoing criminal investigation.

It should be noted that the suspects who fled the scene dumped additional stolen property from similar robberies that occurred previously in Miami Dade County's jurisdiction as well as North Miami Beach. Both agencies have been notified and are currently investigating.
