DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT: On today’s date, the Pembroke Pine Police Department served a Search Warrant at the listed residence regarding the practice of administering cosmetic medical procedures without a license.

Initial information was obtained from a former client/patient of the suspect who in December of 2013 suffered an adverse reaction after receiving Botox injections from the suspect.

Investigation revealed that the listed suspect was performing unlicensed cosmetic procedures inside the garage of her residence. The garage was converted to have the appearance of a doctor’s office. Some of the procedures the suspect was performing included Botox injections, filler injections, vitamin injections, plasma therapy and Carboxy therapy.

The suspect is not duly licensed in the State of Florida to perform the aforementioned treatments and her actions are a third degree felony.
