INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On 04-18-15 at 11:00 a.m., the City of Pembroke Pines will be celebrating it's 55th Birthday with a parade that will run along Pines Boulevard. The parade will start at McArthur High School (6501 Pines Blvd) and travel west along Pines Boulevard, ending at the Pines Recreation Center (7400 Pines Blvd). Pines Boulevard will be completely shut down from 64th Avenue to 76th Avenue from 10:30 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. (noon) while the parade is in progress. During these times, the following detour routes will be available off of Pines Boulevard to allow for travel around the parade route:

- 64th Avenue north to Johnson St to travel east or west
- 63rd Terrace south, to 2nd Street west, to 64th Way south, to 68th Boulevard south, to Pembroke Rd to travel east or west
- 76th Avenue north to Johnson Street to travel east or west

Additionally, during the road closure (10:30 a.m. until 12:00), motorists with business on Broward College Campus will be allowed to enter the campus from a single lane of eastbound Pines Boulevard which will be staffed by an officer. All other eastbound traffic will be diverted north on 76th Ave or back west on Pines Boulevard.

TO ENTER BROWARD COLLEGE CAMPUS:

Travel east on Pines Boulevard to the far west perimeter road of the Broward College Campus, then travel south making a left turn between the baseball fields and basketball courts.

TO EXIT BROWARD COLLEGE CAMPUS:

Travel east through the Broward College Campus and then south towards the Fire Station gate at the southeast corner of Campus. Once exiting at the Fire Station, motorists will need to travel east on 6th Street to 63rd Terrace or south on 72nd Avenue to Pembroke Road in order to circumvent the road closures along Pines Boulevard.

No Traffic will be allowed to travel north on 72nd Avenue while the parade is in progress.

Once the parade is over, Pines Boulevard will be reopened and traffic will be allowed to flow as normal.
