DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT: **DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:** On April 23, 2015 at approximately 530 pm, Pembroke Pines Police officers responded to a call of a missing juvenile at the above location (West Broward High School). Denaysia attended school, but left after her third period class (1150 am) and did not return home. Denaysia resides at a group home, who reported her missing from the school . On April 24, 2015, the group home found a letter written by the juvenile which stated she was depressed and considering suicide.

The Pembroke Pines Police Department is seeking the media and public's assistance in locating the missing juvenile. If you have any information that can assist in helping safely locate Denaysia Renay Walker, please contact police immediately.
