INCIDENT SUMMARY:

*****UPDATE - 08/04/2015, 5PM*****

On 08/03/2015 at 9:45PM the victim, identified as Everan Forbes, died as a result of injuries sustained during this incident.

Investigation has revealed that the suspect, identified as Shawn Forbes and brother of the victim, intentionally struck the victim with his vehicle. Witness statements have revealed that after entering his vehicle the suspect accelerated to speeds over 30 MPH and made no attempt to stop before or after striking the victim.

The suspect is currently in custody at Broward County Main Jail after turning himself in. Charges of Premeditated Murder in the First Degree have been filed against the suspect in regards to this incident.

The probable cause affidavit regarding suspect Shawn Forbes can be found attached to this release.
