INCIDENT SUMMARY:

******* Information Update 9/11/15, 9:30PM*******

The investigation has determined that suspects #1 - #4 entered the listed residence with the intent of committing a home invasion robbery. One occupant of the residence discharged a firearm striking suspect #4, who was fatally wounded. Further investigation revealed that suspect #5 assisted in the planning and facilitating of the robbery.

Suspects #1 - #5 are listed as follows:

- 1) Milton Desir 3-17-95 of Miramar, Florida
- 2) Cleveland Glover 8-29-92 of Miramar, Florida
- 3) Eddrick Butler 12-8-93 of Hallandale Beach, Florida
- 4) Milot Desir 9-7-92 (deceased) of Miramar, Florida
- 5) Alexis Brantley 3-1-97 of Miami, Florida

Suspects #1 - #3, and #5 were charged with Home Invasion Robbery and Felony Murder (related to the death of suspect #4).

This remains an active investigation, and no further information will be provided at this time.

On 09/11/2015 at 12:49 AM, the Pembroke Pines Police Department responded to 11938 SW 12 Street in regards to a possible shooting. While officers were responding to this location a vehicle arrived at Memorial Hospital West (703 N. Flamingo Road) with one of the occupants having sustained a gunshot wound. The subject was pronounced deceased at the hospital.

This remains an active investigation as detectives gather evidence and speak with all parties located at both locations at the time of the incident. Information on the victim is pending notification of next of kin. Additional information will be provided as soon as it becomes available.
