DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Beginning **April 28th, 2016**, the Pembroke Pines Police Department will begin the enforcement portion of the High Visibility Enforcement of Pedestrian & Bicycle Safety initiative. Officers at targeted locations within the city that observe violations by motorists, pedestrians, and bicyclists, will issue Uniform Traffic Citations which carry fines ranging from \$63.50 to \$263.00. The enforcement portion of the campaign will run through May 30th, 2016.
