INCIDENT SUMMARY:

At approximately 9:35 am, members of the Pembroke Pines Police and Fire Departments responded to North Perry Airport as a result of an airplane crash. An investigation determined a student pilot, Luis Castillo, was operating a 1982 Cessna Skyhawk model 172P (tail number N65645). At landing, the aircraft skidding from the runway, traveled on the air field, and ultimately collided with a runway identification marker sign. The incident caused approximately \$4,500.00 of property damage to the runway sign, and approximately \$10,000.00 of property damage to the aircraft. The pilot did not report any injury, and no other passengers were on board.

The Federal Aviation Administration responded to further the investigation.
