INCIDENT SUMMARY:

*****UPDATE*****

On Sunday, January 15, 2017, at 10:28 pm, Mr. Rose died as a result of injuries sustained in this crash. This remains an active investigation.

On Wednesday, January 11, 2017, at 1:55 pm, Members of the Pembroke Pines Police and Fire Departments responded to a vehicle that plunged into a body of water at the listed location.

Preliminary investigation revealed Victim #1 was the driver of a 2004 Toyota Highlander, and Victim #2 was the front passenger. It appears likely the driver suffered an apparent medical complication, and lost control of the vehicle while travelling through a parking lot. This action caused the vehicle to deviate from the asphalt, mount several cement curbs, travel down an embankment, and ultimately enter a body of water.

Three witnesses, and responding police officers actively tried to remove the occupants from the submerged vehicle, but were unable to safely do so. Within minutes, members of the Pembroke Pines Police Dive Team recovered both occupants who were immediately transported for medical attention.

Despite all life-saving efforts, Victim #2 was declared deceased when she arrived at Memorial Miramar Hospital. Victim #1 remains in critical condition.
