## **INCIDENT SUMMARY:**

The listed missing person is believed to have been at his home (above address) some time between midnight and 7:00 pm on 2.15.17. His vehicle was located parked a couple of blocks from the residence. The MP left a suicide note and texted his girlfriend that he wanted to die. He left his car keys, cell phone and wallet behind, and took his firearm which he kept in a lockbox at home. It is believed that the MP is armed, and could pose a danger to himself.
