DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

On March 21, 2017, the Pembroke Pines Police Department transitioned to the enforcement phase of the High Visibility Enforcement of Pedestrian & Bicycle Safety initiative. Officers will target specified intersections and improve safety for those who access a crosswalk. If violations are observed by law enforcement, members of the Traffic Unit will issue Uniform Traffic Citations which carry fines ranging from \$63.50 to \$263.00. The enforcement phase of the campaign will run through to May 15, 2017.
