INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On Sunday, April 16, 2017, at 3:18 pm, members of the Pembroke Pines Police Department received notification from concerned citizens that two juveniles could be in danger.

An investigation revealed that both victims were seated in the back row of a parked vehicle. The suspect was in the driver's seat and appeared intoxicated and incoherent. Both victims acted under stress, were without adequate supervision, and in need of the necessary sustenance of health.

Officers arrested the suspect and transported her to Broward County Jail. Members of the Broward Sheriff's Office Child Protective Investigative Section (CPIS) responded and assumed responsibility and care for both victims.

The Pembroke Pines Police Department urges all members of the community to report any incident that might cause harm to a child, or other person.
