INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On Saturday, June 3, 2017, at 9:44 PM, Members of the Pembroke Pines Police and Fire Departments responded to a vehicle versus pedestrian crash at Pines Blvd and SW 136 Avenue.

Preliminary investigation revealed Victim #1 (Robert Leo Peterson) was walking south in the cross walk on the west side of Pines Blvd and 136 Avenue. Peter Brian Montans of 17392 SW 33 Street, Miramar, FL, was driving his 2016 Mazda CX-5, east on Pines Blvd., in the right turn lane and was approaching SW 136 Avenue. Peterson crossed into the Mazda's path and was struck, resulting in minor damage to the vehicle and serious injuries to himself. Witnesses reported that the traffic light was green for eastbound traffic at the time of the crash.

Fire Rescue arrived and transported Peterson to Memorial Regional Hospital for treatment.

This remains an active investigation.
