## **INCIDENT SUMMARY:**

**On Friday, 11.17.2017, at 4:39 pm, members of the Pembroke Pines Police and Fire Departments responded to a suspicious person reportedly walking on runway 10L28R of the North Perry Airport.**

**When Pembroke Pines Police Officers approached the suspect, he ran away. However, the suspect was apprehended within seconds. While the suspect was handcuffed, he claimed to be HIV positive, and spit saliva directly and intentionally on a police officer.**

**The suspect was arrested for Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer, as well as Trespassing. The investigation further revealed the suspect required medical evaluation.**
