INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On Thursday, November 9, 2017, at 7:20 PM, members of the Pembroke Pines Police and Fire Departments responded to a vehicle versus pedestrian crash in the 9900 block of Pines Blvd.

Preliminary investigation revealed Victim #1 (Larry Edwin Timm) was walking southbound across Pines Blvd. in the 9900 block. Maydi Alcaz of 6870 SW 5 Court, Pembroke Pines, FL, was driving her 2013 Toyota Sienna east on Pines Blvd., in the right turn lane and was approaching the 9900 block. As the Toyota approached, Timm crossed into its path and was struck, resulting in minor damage to the vehicle and serious injuries to himself. Witnesses reported that Timm was crossing mid-block in a poorly lit area and was wearing dark clothing at the time of the crash.

Fire Rescue transported Timm to Memorial Regional Hospital for treatment. Ms. Alcaz did not sustain any injuries due to the crash.

This remains an active investigation.
