INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On Sunday, November 12, 2017, at approximately 3:19 am, members of the Pembroke Pines Police and Fire-Rescue responded to the 1200 block of South University Drive regarding a vehicle versus bicyclist crash.

The initial investigation revealed that the victim, Jonadin Saint-Louis of Miramar, FL, was riding his bicycle northbound on South University Drive, within the bicycle lane and was approaching the 1200 block. Meanwhile, Alexandra Malukah Olivier, of Miramar, FL, was driving a 2013 Hyundai Tucson northbound on South University Drive, in the right lane and was approaching the 1200 block. Paula Jennie Santiago, of Davie, FL, was riding as a passenger in the Hyundai. In the 1200 block of South University Drive, the Hyundai struck the bicycle from the rear, causing Mr. Saint-Louis to be ejected from the bicycle onto the hood and windshield of the car. Mr. Saint-Louis remained on the vehicle briefly and then fell to the roadway. Mr. Saint-Louis died at the scene.

Both occupants of the Hyundai reported failing to see the bicycle prior to the crash. They said they heard a “bang” and the airbags deployed filling the vehicle’s interior with smoke. Fearing the vehicle was on fire, they both jumped from the moving vehicle and suffered minor injuries from impacting the roadway. The Hyundai continued travelling north on University Drive, until it struck a concrete pole in the 100 block of North University Drive. A passerby reached into the vehicle and turned off the ignition to prevent any further damage.

The driver and passenger of the Hyundai were transported to Memorial Regional Hospital and Memorial Hospital Pembroke for treatment.

No further information will be released at this time; this remains an active investigation.
