INCIDENT SUMMARY:

At approx. 2320 hours, officers were dispatched to the area of the Bayberry townhome community in reference to anonymous calls of shots being heard in the area. At approx. 2344 hrs, while canvassing the surrounding area an officer located an apartment with apparent bullet damage.

An examination of the apartment found multiple bullet holes in the walls and ceilings of several rooms. Contacts was made with several persons inside the apartment complex. Two victims stated the suspect pointed the firearm at them, stating, "Get out of my way" as he made his way to an awaiting vehicle, fleeing south out of the community. The suspect was described as being a young black male (n.o.i.) driving a newer model black Hyundai Sonata.

No one sustained any injuries as a result of this incident. We are seeking the public and media's assistance in locating the possible suspect.
