**On 09/28/17, one of the witnesses was able to assist with a digital composite sketch of the subject, based on their interaction. We are disseminating the new sketch in hopes that it will assist in the identification of the subject. **A third possible incident was reported at approximately 1045 PM on 09/25/17. At 6:00AM, an unknown male subject pulled up in a vehicle next to a juvenile who was waiting at his bus stop at NW 96th Avenue and Pines Blvd. The subject asked the juvenile if he needed to charge his cell phone. The juvenile told the subject no and then walked away as the vehicle drove off.**

\*\*\*\*\*UPDATE 09/25/17\*\*\*\*\*

On today's date, Monday 09/25/17, a third incident possibly involving the same subject and vehicle description occurred in the area of 85<sup>th</sup> Avenue and NW 6 Street. The subject approached two juveniles and asked to use their cell phone to get directions, as he was lost. The juveniles did not give the subject their phones and walked away. The juveniles advised the subject matched the composite sketch in the initial media release. One of the juveniles was able to give a detailed description of the vehicle, which is as follows: A newer model four door white Mazda 3, with no tint on the front windows, and tint to the rear windows. We are asking anyone with information to please contact the Pembroke Pines Police Department @ 954-431-2200.

On Monday, 09/18/17, there were separate suspicious incidents reported by two juvenile females within an hour time frame. Both females stated that a subject, who looks like the above composite sketches, stopped in his vehicle to make conversation with them and asked them for directions to the Sawgrass Mills Mall. The male attempted to make small talk and offered to charge one of their cell phones. The male also asked the females to get closer to his vehicle, and on one of the occasions he opened his trunk and asked the juvenile to get closer. The juveniles walked away from the male without further incident. This is for informational and safety purposes only at this time.

We are asking for public's assistance in reporting any similar instances and in locating the suspect for questioning.
