INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On Friday, January 12, 2018 at approximately 4:24 pm, members of the Pembroke Pines Police and Fire-Rescue Departments responded to the 100 block of SW 184 Avenue regarding a two vehicle crash with injuries. Initial investigation revealed, Mr. Rothberg was driving his 2006 Buick Terraza west in the exit of Wal-Mart and was approaching SW 184 Ave. Mr. Egues was driving his 2016 Toyota 4Runner north on SW 184 Ave, in the right lane and was approaching the 100 block. As the Toyota continued north, the Buick failed to yield right of way from the stop sign and turned right into its path. The Toyota struck the driver's side of the Buick, resulting in disabling damages to both vehicles and injuries to both drivers. Mr. Rothberg was transported to Memorial Regional Hospital for treatment; Mr. Egues declined medical assistance.

On Monday, January 15, 2018 at 6:00 pm, THI J Black was notified by the Broward Medical Examiner's Office that Mr. Rothberg died while being treated for injuries sustained in this crash. The BME advised Mr. Rothberg was pronounced deceased on Monday, January 15, 2018 at 1645 hours, by Doctor Corgan of Memorial Regional Hospital.

This is an active investigation and no additional information will be released at this time.
