### **INCIDENT SUMMARY:**

**On Tuesday, 01.09.2018, at 12:05 p.m., members of the Pembroke Pines Police and Fire Departments responded to a traffic crash at the intersection of Pines Boulevard and Douglas Road.**

**A preliminary investigation revealed that Driver 1 was operating a 2008 Suzuki XL-7 westbound on Pines Boulevard, approaching Douglas Road. Driver 2 was operating a 2012 Toyota Corolla, also westbound on Pines Boulevard, ahead of Vehicle 1's position.**

**According to witnesses, the westbound traffic signal displayed green, and the flow of traffic advanced through the intersection.**



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**As Vehicle 1 entered the intersection, it rear-ended Vehicle 2, in what seemingly appeared to be a minor collision. After the first series of events, Vehicle 1 travelled toward the northwest corner of the intersection and ultimately collided with a concrete pole.**

**The subsequent series of events caused injury to both occupants of Vehicle 1. Pembroke Pines Fire Rescue transported Driver 1 to Memorial Regional Hospital, and Passenger 1 was trauma alerted to Memorial Regional Hospital.**

**Driver 2 was evaluated on scene by Pembroke Pines Fire Rescue. Since Driver 2 claimed no injury, she was not transported for medical attention.**

**On Friday, 01.19.2018, ten (10) days following the initial crash, the Pembroke Pines Police Department received notification from the Broward County Medical Examiner's Office that Driver 1 died as a result of the injuries he sustained during this crash.**

**At this time, no additional information is expected to release until the final outcome of the Traffic Unit's investigation is concluded.**
