INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On January 20, 2018 at approximately 6:30pm, members of the Pembroke Pines Police were dispatched to the above location regarding a possible shooting. While enroute to the location information was obtained that a male victim was dropped off at Memorial Urgent Care with a gunshot wound to the shoulder area. The initial investigation revealed that multiple subjects engaged in a physical altercation at the above location at which time unknown suspect(s) fired several rounds one of which struck the victim. The victim was transported to Memorial Regional Hospital from Memorial Urgent Care in stable condition.

At this time the circumstances as to why this incident occurred are still unknown due to uncooperative parties.
