The victim's family has kindly requested that the media respect their privacy, as they do not wish to provide a statement or be contacted. Detectives are actively pursuing all leads in this case. At the time that this incident occurred, it is possible that the suspect(s) may have also had access to the adjacent community (Heron's Pond) to where the incident occurred. Based on the information we have gathered thus far, we believe that this was an isolated incident and not a random act of violence. There is no continued threat to the community stemming from this incident. However, as a violent suspect(s) remains at large, we are asking for all residents who live in the area of either community (Gatehouse or Heron's Pond) to please contact the Pembroke Pines Police Department if they have any information pertaining to this incident. As soon as any pertinent information is available, we will update this media release.

Pembroke Pines Police Officers responded to Memorial Hospital Pembroke, in response to a call of a gun shot victim that had been dropped off at the emergency room. When they arrived, officers were advised by emergency room staff that lifesaving efforts were not successful, and the victim had been declared deceased. His identity will not be released until next of kin is notified.

At present, detectives are actively investigating leads in an effort to find the suspect. It is possible that the incident occurred in the parking area of the Gatehouse Apartment Complex. Once additional information is available, this media release will be updated.
