INCIDENT SUMMARY

On Friday, May 25, 2018 at 2:11 p.m., members of the Pembroke Pines Police & Fire Departments responded to a physical fight with a report of one gun-shot fired.

An investigation revealed that Suspect #1 and #2 were shopping within the Sears department store. Suspect #3 was also shopping within the same store and carrying a 1 year old child on his hip. All suspects coincidentally encountered each other, and a verbal argument unfolded.

In addition to caring a child, Suspect #3 was legally carrying a concealed firearm which was holstered in his waistband.

Within moments, the verbal argument escalated into a physical fight between Suspects #1, #2, and #3. During the brawl, Suspect #1 and Suspect #3 seemingly struggled over possession

of the firearm all while standing upright. At one point, Suspect #1 and Suspect #3 fell to the ground as the fight ensued. During the struggle, a single and unintended discharge occurred, after Suspect #1 emerged with the firearm.

The single gun-shot fragmented into the tile floor, which caused Suspect #3 to sustain a minor injury to his lip, and caused Suspect #1 to sustain a minor injury to his left, lower leg.

Suspect #3 was evaluated at the department store by Pembroke Pines Fire Rescue, and required no further medical treatment while on scene.

Suspect #1 and #2 fled the scene, and soon after reported the incident to law enforcement.

The circumstances of the Detectives' investigation concluded that all suspects are known to one another, and share an unfavorable history with each other. The circumstances further concluded the investigation is not considered an active shooter incident.

The results of the of Detectives' investigation warranted the arrest of Suspect #1, #2, and #3.

Suspect #1 was charged with Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon, Aggravated Battery, and Disorderly Conduct.

Suspect #2 was charged with Battery and Disorderly Conduct.

Suspect #3 was charged with Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon, Disorderly Conduct, and Child Abuse.

No other information pertaining to this incident will release.
