INCIDENT SUMMARY:

At approximately 11:05 p.m. on January, 23, 2019, Victim #1 (Adult Female) was in the area of SW 119 Avenue & SW 15th Street within The Avant community. Victim #1 advised that she was directly outside of Building 134 when she observed an unknown male suspect in the parking lot. The suspect was wearing a long sleeved sweater & pants, and had a dark shirt wrapped around his head which concealed everything but his eyes.

Victim #1 observed the suspect vigorously rubbing his genitals through his pants. Victim #1 proceeded to yell for help, whereupon the suspect began approaching her. Victim #1 then ran towards the apartment building, causing the suspect to flee westbound into The Avant community. During this incident the suspect did not expose his genitals, did not make physical contact with Victim #1, and did not say anything.

A few minutes later a similar incident occurred in the area of SW 119 Avenue & SW 14 Street. Victim #2 (Adult Female) and Victim #3 (Adult Female) were located outside of Building 106 when they observed the suspect following them through the parking lot. The suspect matched the same description as the previous incident, and was masturbating his exposed penis while looking at Victim #2 and Victim #3. Both victims retreated towards the nearest building, and the suspect fled westbound back into The Avant community. During this incident, the suspect did

not make physical contact with either victim, and did not say anything.



Detectives believe that these incidents are related to previous cases which occurred within The Avant and Harbor Cove communities in December 2017, October 2018, and November 2018. (See attached media release.) In all of these cases, the suspect is described as a white, possibly Hispanic, male between 5'8" and 5'10" in height, with a slim build. The suspect is always described as wearing all black clothing, with a blanket, ski mask, or shirt concealing his face. In addition, the suspect may have light-colored eyes and a tattoo on his abdomen.

We are asking all residents in the vicinity of The Avant and Harbor Cove communities to use caution during the evening & night-time hours, and to be aware of any suspicious persons loitering in community parking lots or near buildings.
