INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On January 31, 2019, at approximately 2:09 a.m. the Pembroke Pines Police Department received a call involving a stolen Fort Lauderdale Police Marked Unit. Officers were notified that the vehicle was travelling northbound on Palm Ave in the City of Pembroke Pines.

Responding officers observed the vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed. The suspect refused to stop and, in an effort to evade police capture, he struck a light pole and bailed out of the vehicle. The suspect was apprehended after a brief foot chase. He was transported to Memorial Regional Hospital for medical clearance.
