INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On April 30, 2019, at approximately 10:11 a.m., Pembroke Pines Police Officers observed a suspected stolen vehicle traveling in the area of 7100 Pembroke Road. This same vehicle had previously fled from our officers on April 28, 2019. Our officers proceeded to follow the vehicle as it traveled eastbound along Pembroke Road. At this time, a BOLO containing the vehicle description was dispatched to Hollywood Police Department.

A traffic stop was attempted at Plunkett Street and 441 in Hollywood, whereupon the suspect (Antonio Edward Hernandez Jr.) placed his vehicle in reverse and knowingly and intentionally rammed one of our occupied police vehicles. The suspect then fled eastbound through the City of Hollywood, and eventually came to a stop after crashing into a pole at the southbound exit

Due to the suspect's vehicle overturning as a result of the crash, the suspect had to be extracted by Fire-Rescue. The suspect received non-life threatening injuries, and was transported to Memorial Regional Hospital for treatment. The officer that was operating the struck vehicle was transported to Memorial Pembroke Hospital as a precaution.

This remains an active criminal investigation, and no additional information will be released at this time.
