INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On July 1, 2019, at approximately 2:59 a.m., officers were contacted by a reportee advising of an on-going domestic disturbance inside of the Cobblestone community (SW 146 Terrace and SW 9th Street). The reportee advised that he was on a Facetime call with the suspect, who was inside of the victim's residence with a firearm and threatening to kill her. The victim and the suspect are in a relationship, but do not currently reside together.

Prior to police being notified, the suspect had fired three warning shots inside of the residence in order to scare the victim. The victim's two children, who were inside of the residence at the time, were safely removed from the home by the suspect's father.

The reportee stated that the suspect threatened to kill his wife and any responding officers if he detected police presence. Due to these threats, officers concealed their presence outside of the victim's home. Officers were in contact with the reportee during this time, who convinced the suspect to leave the residence.

At approximately 4:15 a.m., the suspect exited the home, entered his vehicle, and proceeded to exit the Cobblestone community. Officers followed the suspect until he was a safe distance from nearby residences, whereupon they conducted a felony traffic stop. The suspect was safely taken into custody, and a firearm was located inside of his vehicle.

The victim was transported to Memorial Miramar Hospital for treatment regarding injuries she sustained during the incident. The victim has invoked her rights via Marsy's Law to keep her information confidential.

The suspect faces charges of Burglary of an Occupied Residence With a Firearm, False Imprisonment, Aggravated Battery with a Deadly Weapon, Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon, Child Endangerment, Violation of a Restraining Order, Unlawful Discharge of a Firearm, Theft of a Firearm, and Unlawful Possession of a Controlled Substance.
