**Update at 5:15 p.m. on Monday, August 26, 2019**

**Detectives concluded that Suspect #1 (Pablo Colon, Jr.) shot and fatally wounded his wife, mother in-law, and 3-year-old daughter before ending his own life with a self-inflicted gunshot wound.**

**The surviving daughter was released from a local hospital, and is currently within the care of family members until child custody arrangements are established.**

**This update provides an exact location of occurrence, a revised incident classification, and identity information of the victims and suspect.**

At 8:27 p.m. on Sunday, August 25, 2019, members of the Pembroke Pines Police and Fire Departments responded to a suspicious incident located near the 1600 block of SW 156 Avenue.

As police officers responded to the residence, 911 operators upgraded the call and provided information that a male subject murdered family members and intended to end his own life. When police officers arrived, a rapid action team was immediately assembled and first responders entered the home.

A preliminary investigation revealed multiple deceased victims, seemingly from gunshot wounds.

Rapid action team members located a child, and Fire Rescue immediately transported the victim to an area hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

This incident remains under an active investigation, appears domestic in nature, and involves no threat to the community.
