### **INCIDENT SUMMARY:**

In March 2017, the Pembroke Pines Police Department began the process of obtaining reaccreditation through the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation (CFA). As part of this process, our agency will be hosting a team of assessors from November 12th to November 14th who will conduct a mock assessment of our policies, practices, and facilities. This mock assessment is intended to measure the agency's compliance with over 217 state-recognized standards necessary to maintain a properly functioning and fully accountable police department, and prepares our agency for the final CFA accreditation assessment which will be taking place in the first quarter of 2020. Over the course of the assessment, the agency's policies will be reviewed, staff will be interviewed, and physical inspections will be made to our Police Headquarters, West District Substation, Training Facility, and our field equipment.

As part of this process, we are inviting our residents to submit their comments to the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation in regards to our agency. Upon completion of the CFA assessors' on-site examination, all findings will be submitted to the Commission for Florida Law Enforcement Accreditation to determine if the Pembroke Pines Police Department has satisfied all requirements to obtain accreditation status. Once obtained, accreditation status is valid for a three-year period during which the Department must maintain the standards of best practices set by the CFA. After the three-year period is over, the agency is re-assessed through the same on-site examination process.

Through the Pembroke Pines Police Department's dedication to excellence, and the assistance of our CFA Program Manager Billy Walls, we are committed to exceeding the requirements for each CFA standard.
