INCIDENT SUMMARY:

Two suspects have been taken into custody on Burglary and Theft charges after residents shared RING doorbell footage, via the Neighbors by RING app, showing the suspects committing crimes at multiple locations within the city.

Two separate video clips were obtained by our detectives from the Neighbors by RING web portal. The first video depicts Suspect #1 (Paul Rodriguez) approaching a residence in the area of NW 104th Avenue & NW 22nd Street, whereupon he can be seen stealing two packages that were left on the victim's front porch.

The second video depicts Suspect #2 (Vanessa Santos) approaching a residence in the area of NW 81st Avenue & NW 13th Street. Suspect #2 can be seen stealing a decorative Halloween item from the victim's front porch.

After reviewing the video footage, our detectives were able to positively identify both individuals as known suspects.

On October 31, 2019, Paul Rodriguez and Vanessa Santos were safely taken into custody by Pembroke Pines Police detectives at Rodriguez's residence in Pembroke Pines. In addition to Burglary and Petit Theft charges, Rodriguez faces additional charges of Resisting an Officer Without Violence.
