### **INCIDENT SUMMARY:**

A victim received non-life threatening injuries after being shot in the foot by an unknown suspect following an attempted transaction of misdemeanor marijuana inside of the Malibu Bay community.

At approximately 7:30 p.m. on November 26, 2019, officers responded to the Malibu Bay community regarding reports of a shooting which had just occurred. Officers made contact with the adult male victim, who received a single gunshot wound to his foot. The victim advised that he arranged to meet with the suspect(s) regarding the sale / purchase of marijuana.

Our investigation determined that the victim had arranged to meet with the suspect(s) in the Malibu Bay community parking lot (500 Block of NW 208<sup>th</sup> Way). Two subjects exited a black

Audi and entered into the backseat of the victim's parked vehicle. At some point during this interaction, a third unknown suspect approached the drivers-side window and pointed a firearm at the victim. The victim exited his vehicle and ran away, as the suspect followed him. The victim and suspect then stopped and had a verbal exchange, at which time the suspect fired a single gunshot toward the victim, striking him in his foot.

All three suspects then fled the area in the black Audi.

During our investigation the victim was not fully cooperative, and refused to provide integral information and evidence pertinent to the incident. At this time, no suspect descriptions are available.

The victim was transported by Pembroke Pines Fire-Rescue to Memorial Regional Hospital for treatment.

This incident is believed to be isolated based on the circumstances involved. No safety alerts are being issued for the surrounding area.

This remains an active criminal investigation, and additional information may be released upon availability.
