INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On Tuesday, December 03, 2019 at approximately 2:04 p.m., the Pembroke Pines Police Department received notification from representatives of Memorial Regional Hospital regarding an endangered missing person.

An investigation revealed at approximately 11:00 a.m., Freddie Lee Jones, Jr. was transported by private ambulance from Memorial Regional Hospital to the Citrus Health Network for voluntary patient admission. It was later determined by a Memorial Regional Hospital case worker that the missing person did not register within the Citrus Health Network's admission process, and ultimately walked away from the facility.
