INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On Wednesday, December 4, 2019, members of our Pembroke Pines Police patrol division were conducting traffic enforcement along the US 27 corridor. At approximately 10:49PM our officers observed a marked North Bay Village Police Department vehicle traveling northbound in the southbound lanes of US 27, with its overhead emergency lights activated.

A traffic stop was conducted, and the driver was ordered out of the vehicle. The driver was identified as James Stephen McVay (Suspect #1), who is currently employed as a Sergeant with the North Bay Village Police Department. McVay was not in uniform at the time of the traffic stop.

Based upon our subsequent investigation, McVay was taken into custody for driving under the influence. McVay was transported to BSO BAT for processing, and then to BSO Main Jail.
