INCIDENT SUMMARY:

Pembroke Pines Police Officers responded to a report of a male suspect who broke into a home near SW 85 Terrace & SW 2 Street. When the home-invasion happened, an adult male victim and an adult female victim were within the residence.

Victim #1 advised that the suspect is a known acquaintance (later identified as 20-year-old Carlos Santiago Duran) who entered the home by climbing an exterior balcony and opening a sliding glass door. The victim stated that Duran was armed with a knife and attempted to kill him.

While Duran was holding Victim #1 at knifepoint, Victim #2 attempted to disarm him.

When Victim #1 called 911, Duran ran out of the home and got into an awaiting Honda Civic. The driver, identified as 22-year-old Jorge Jacobs Jacome, fled at a high rate of speed and refused to stop when responding officers first spotted the vehicle. After a brief pursuit, Jacome stopped the vehicle at a nearby gas station located at 50 North University Drive.

Following our initial investigation, it was determined that Victim #1 and Duran were involved in a verbal argument at a social event earlier that evening. Afterward, both suspects arrived at the victim's residence and worked together so that Duran could scale the home's second floor balcony to enter the residence.

Duran is charged with attempted murder, armed burglary, aggravated assault with a deadly weapon and false imprisonment. Jacome is charged with attempted felony murder, armed burglary, fleeing and eluding, and other traffic related offenses. Both suspects were transported to Broward County Jail.

Investigators determined that this incident is isolated in nature and there are no safety concerns to the community.
