INCIDENT SUMMARY:

On Saturday, October 26, 2024, at 12:56 a.m. members of the Pembroke Pines Police Department responded to 11700 Sheridan Street after a report of shots fired in the area. When police officers arrived, they noticed a crashed Nissan Altima and confirmed the driver was shot.

The driver was immediately transported to a nearby hospital with life threatening injuries caused by the gunfire and regrettably died despite all emergency medical care.

Based on a preliminary investigation, detectives believe at least two vehicles were driving reckless along Sheridan Street. An occupant from one vehicle fired shots at the driver of the Nissan Altima.
