TESTING SCHEDULE

All written and practical testing will be conducted at 4180 NW 120th Avenue or 4150 NW 120th Avenue in Coral Springs. This is the main CSRIPS building and the building immediately adjacent to the south. The swim portion will be held at the Coral Springs Aquatic Center at 12441 Royal Palm Boulevard, Coral Springs.

March 14: Orientation and Written Exam

- Doors close and registration begins promptly at TBD. Time will be posted after registration closes.

March 15: Swim Test

- 12441 Royal Palm Blvd., Coral Springs, Florida 33065
- Doors close and registration begins promptly at TBD. Time will be posted after registration closes.
- Required Dress Code: t-shirt, pants (BDU's), belt, and socks. No yoga pants, sweat pants or sweatshirts.

March 21: Paramedic Practical Testing

- Doors close and registration begins promptly at TBD. Time will be posted after registration closes.

March 21: Fire Practical

- 4150 NW 120th Avenue, Coral Springs, Florida 33065
- Doors close and registration begins promptly at TBD. Time will be posted after registration closes.

Being late for any part of the testing will result in immediate dismissal and there will be no opportunity for a make-up.

Parking: For written and practical testing, please find parking in either lot at 4150 NW 120th Avenue or 4180 NW 120th Avenue. Do not park on the street.

APPLICATION PROCESS

IMPORTANT! This is NOT the application to apply for the Pembroke Pines Fire Rescue Department. This is the application to apply for the testing portion of the application only!

You must complete this March 2020 NHA for your application. Previous attempts are not eligible.

Each candidate must have their valid certifications during the registration period. Once the registration period is closed no additional applicants will be taken for that testing period. All candidates will be required to upload the following documents to complete the application:

1. VALID DRIVERS LICENSE
2. STATE OF FLORIDA FIREFIGHTER 1 & 2 COMPETENCY or DEPT ID
3. STATE OF FLORIDA PARAMEDIC
4. EMERGENCY VEHICLE OPERATORS COURSE (EVOC)
5. CPAT (National)
 1. **Pembroke Pines Fire Rescue accepts CPAT.**
 2. Candidates successfully making it past the practical tests will be required to pass a swim test.
 3. CPAT is valid for 1 year and must be valid on March 22, 2020. If you do not have a CPAT, please check with Palm Beach State College for the next scheduled CPAT.
