

The Carl Shechter Southwest Focal Point Community Center will be closing to the public effective March 18th, 2020. We are tentatively scheduled to reopen on March 30th, 2020. PLEASE NOTE: For only those people whose assigned polling place is the SWFP Community Center, we will be open on Election Day, March 17th, 2020 from 7am to 7pm.

Although the Center will be closed, service provision will continue, as follows:

- The SWFP Adult/Alzheimer's daycare which is managed by Easter Seals shall remain open. Their hours of operation are Monday through Friday from 7am to 6pm, and Saturday from 8am to 4pm. Daycare staff shall follow CDC guidelines in an effort to protect their clientele and staff.
- The Center provides over 60 meals through Meals on Wheels (MOW) on a daily basis. MOW will deliver 7 days of meals to SWFP, and in collaboration with our transportation division, Center staff will hand deliver these meals directly to MOW participants.
- The senior transportation service will continue to provide rides to registered members for such things as doctor appointments, grocery shopping, and prescription pickup at local pharmacies. Note: this senior transportation service is provided to registered Pembroke Pines residents.
- The City's community shuttle service will continue to run as normal (following BCT), providing transportation throughout the city and connecting riders to Broward County Transit.

Please note that the SWFP senior center staff will be contacting all of its registered members (approximately 6500) to perform wellness checks. This will provide us with an opportunity to update each member's information, as well as address any questions or concerns. Referrals to available services will be made.

In addition, Pines Point and Pines Place housing offices will remain open and fully staffed. In an effort to follow CDC guidelines, all tenants are to contact their respective office via phone with their questions or housing needs.

We look forward to a return to normal operations, and will keep you advised as more information becomes available.
