

COVID 19 DIAGNOSTIC TEST

Get tested before returning to work Your Safety Comes First

As businesses reopen in South Broward County and employees return to work, the safety of our community is our highest priority. To help prevent employees from transmitting COVID-19 in the workplace, we are encouraging employers to ask employees who are 18+ to get tested, before returning to work, for free at the C.B. Smith Park Drive-Through Community Testing Site in Pembroke Pines.

Everyone seeking a COVID-19 diagnostic test at C.B. Smith Park must pre-register.

PLEASE FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS BELOW:

- Call **954-276-4680**, 7 days a week, 7:30 am to 5:30 pm
- You will be provided with a confirmation number
- A pre-packet will be waiting for you at C.B. Smith Park
- Bring a valid ID (i.e., driver's license, passport or state-issued identification card (no pictures or photo copies)
- Note: If multiple individuals are coming in one car, each individual must be pre-registered

C.B. Smith Park Drive-Through Community Testing Site is operated by the Florida National Guard in cooperation with Memorial Healthcare System and the Florida Department of Health, at the direction of the Office of the Governor.



WHAT TO EXPECT AT TESTING SITE

- Drive-through site has five lanes and is accessible by vehicle only (no bicyclists or pedestrians)
- Pre-registered patients will be screened through their vehicle window
- A medic wearing a Tyvek suit will collect a sample with a swab of the nose through your vehicle window

HOW TO GET TEST RESULTS

- Memorial Healthcare System clinical teams will notify all registrants of positive and negative results by phone
- If you provided an e-mail address during registration, and are not currently a registered Memorial MyChart user, you will receive a link to sign up. You will then be able to view your test results as part of your electronic medical record.
- Quest: To receive results electronically from Quest, register directly with Quest Laboratory.
