### Required Permitting Documents and Information:

- [Building Application](#) – Broward County Uniform Permit Application
- [Electrical Application](#), if applicable
- [Affidavit of Landscape Compliance for Improvements](#) (Residential Lots)
- [Homeowners Association Affidavit of Awareness](#).  
**IMPORTANT:** Must be submitted even if you do not belong to an Association.
- [Utility Easement Hold Harmless Agreement](#)
- Property Survey showing Setbacks and Location
- Site Plan
- If installing PVC or Metal Fence: Please provide Plans/ Drawings signed and sealed by a Florida Licensed Architect/Engineer.  
If installing Wood / Chain link Fences not designed by an Architect or Engineer, must be installed as per the prescribed method on the Florida Building Code, 7<sup>th</sup> Edition.

- If project is located on a [South Broward Drainage \(SBDD\)](#) a permit release must be obtained from [SBDD](#)
- [Notice of Commencement \(NOC\)](#) must be recorded, submitted, and displayed prior to scheduling the first inspection for any non-mechanical project with a job value over \$5,000.  
It is preferred, but not required, to submit the NOC in advance to not hold up the first inspection request.
