**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN,** The Pembroke Pines Police Department is requesting public comment and input on the 2022 Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Local Solicitation Grant program from residents of Pembroke Pines, for a period of (30) days. The Edward Byrne Justice Assistance Grant program is a formula grant to municipalities based on crime statistics. The grant funds are allocated by the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and can be used for a variety of law enforcement programs and activities.

**PROPOSED DISTRIBUTION** , The Pembroke Pines Police Department is eligible to receive \$22,762.44 in grant funding through the 2022 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistant Grant (JAG) from the U.S. Department of Justice. The Pembroke Pines Police Department anticipates utilizing these funds for a General Equipment purchase (radar speed sign trailer) for sworn law enforcement officers.
