The purpose of the Plan is to set forth strategies to increase the delivery of affordable housing within the City of Pembroke Pines pursuant to Section 420,907-9079, Florida Statutes and Rule Chapter 67-37, Florida Administrative Code.

Citizens are encouraged to review the Draft 2022-2023, 2023-2024 and 2024-2025 Local Housing Assistance Plan (LHAP) and provide comment.
