3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF
4 PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA; AMENDING CHAPTER 33
5 ENTITLED "GENERAL CITY POLICIES" OF TITLE III
6 ENTITLED "ADMINISTRATION" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES
7 OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, BY AMENDING
8 SECTION 33.05 ENTITLED "FEES FOR COPYING AND
RESEARCH OF PUBLIC DOCUMENTS", BY INCREASING THE
COST OF DUPLICATING PUBLIC RECORDS FROM TEN (10¢)
CENTS TO FIFTEEN (15¢) CENTS; PROVIDING FOR
CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND
PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

10 WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Pembroke
11 Pines, Florida, deems it to be in the best interests of
12 citizens and residents of the City of Pembroke Pines,
13 Florida, to provide for an increase in the cost of
14 duplicating public records from ten (10¢) cents to fifteen
15 (15¢) cents;

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF
17 THE CITY OF PEMBROKE PINES, FLORIDA, THAT:

18 Section 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clause is true
19 and correct and is hereby ratified and confirmed by the City
20 Commission.

21 Section 2. Section 33.05, of Chapter 33 of Title III
22 of the Pembroke Pines Code of Ordinances is amended as
23 follows:

24 Section 33.05 FEES FOR COPYING AND RESEARCH OF PUBLIC
25 DOCUMENTS.

26 (A) For the purpose of this Section, the
27 following definitions shall apply unless the
context clearly indicates or requires a different
28 meaning.

29 (1) "CHARGE." The amount which the
city may bill a member of the public requesting
documents held by the city.

30 (2) "LABOR CHARGE." The hourly
31 rate of pay for the individual researching or
32 copying documents together with a 30% employee
benefit surcharge.

3 (3) "PUBLIC." Residents or non-
4 residents of the city requesting documents held by
the city.

5 (B) The public shall be charged for copying
6 and research of city documents pursuant to the
following formula:

7 (labor charge x time spent) + (number of
8 copies x ~~\$-10~~ \$.15 per copy) = total charge to
requesting party.

9 Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances,
10 Resolutions or parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith be
11 and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such
12 conflict.


13 Section 4. If any clause, section, or other part or
14 application of this Ordinance shall be held by any court of
15 competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid,
16 such unconstitutional or invalid part or application shall be
17 considered as eliminated and so not effecting the validity of
18 the remaining portions or applications remaining in full
19 force and effect.

20 Section 5. This Ordinance shall become effective
21 immediately upon its passage and adoption.


