## ARTIST APPLICATION

**STUDIO 18 ART COMPLEX** welcomes artists who are committed to their creative process as well as being a part of a dynamic artistic community. Conceptual innovation and technical proficiency are the primary criteria for selection.

Practicing artists of all media are encouraged to submit an application. All applicants must complete this form and submit the requested materials and a non-refundable processing fee. Applications will be reviewed and applicants will be notified of the jury decision.

Please provide us with a portfolio that includes the following:

- One PDF file (preferable) or all work saved on a flash drive.
- Artist Statement
- Resume or curriculum vitae including artistic and professional experience.
- Images of artwork (10 - 15) saved in JPEG format on a flash drive. Include artist name and artwork titles. Titles must be clearly noted.
- One-page information sheet that includes titles of each work, media, dimensions and date executed.
- Completed application, copy of Florida drivers license (*applicant must reside full time in tri county area*) and non-refundable processing fee of \$30.00, check or money order, made payable to the City of Pembroke Pines.
